I hope you all had an enjoyable summer break and are ready for a new and hopefully rewarding school year.

Regrettably, COVID-19 has not magically disappeared in the course of the vacation period; hence there is continued good reason for utmost carefulness in the manner we act in the school.

The Ministry of Education has announced that normal physical teaching may be conducted; yet we need to comply with a number of regulations in our daily behavior:

During class sessions there is no longer the stipulation of the 1-metre distance. However, we request you to refrain from touching each other and to regularly disinfect your hands.

In the hallways, we have set up division lines, so you are reminded to always keep to the right when walking.

In the canteen, please make use of the disinfectant before and after your meal. If the weather allows, please sit outdoors – else sit together by class unit.

It is with regret we needed to cancel all parties until the Fall Break. Thereafter, we may take new decisions depending on the given situation and potential stipulations.

We expect the Sports Day to be conducted as the event is organized by class, and all students are spread out both indoors and outdoors.

This in particular for our new pre-IB students:

The Intro Trip in week 37 (for Danish stx in week 36) are being conducted by class, just as regular school organization. During the trip, all precautions will run like at school, and we will provide moth/nose masks to you all. As announced at our intro meeting in June, the pre-IB trip goes to Flensborg/Germany and costs 600 kr. A special account for your payment will be established; more information at the start of school.

In the case of larger events with several classes attending, they will be held in large locations with a 1-metre distance between chairs.

Please observe the continued regulation: Should you have any symptoms of COVID-19, you need to stay home and be tested asap for a safe and healthy return.
