

Nørre Gymnasium's mobile phone policy for the school year 2023-2024

At Nørre Gymnasium we emphasise that everyone has the opportunity for educational, pedagogical and personal development. We want to be a secondary school that is characterised by professional enthusiasm in a developing and challenging learning environment. The purpose of an STX or IB exam is to prepare students for higher education, including that they acquire general education, knowledge and skills through the education's combination of professional breadth and depth. In order to create the best conditions for educational immersion and a good learning environment, we have a mobile phone policy which should contribute to fewer disturbances.

The policy is as follows:

1g/Pre-IB

- In 1g/Pre-IB, mobile phones must be in the mobile hotel during all modules, both in regular class teaching and in elective classes.
- When teaching in core classes, the hotel space with the number that corresponds to the individual student's ID number on the class list in Lectio is used.
- Mobile phones must be switched off/or on flight mode and be locked with a code or similar.
- Mobile phones must remain in the mobile hotel until the module is over or the teacher gives notice otherwise.
- Mobile phones must therefore also stay in the mobile hotel if the class e.g., is sent on a 'walk and talk' or sent out to work in the modules.
- If everyone leaves the room, the door must be locked.
- The individual teacher can always instruct and decide that mobile phones should not be in the mobile hotel, e.g., if they are to be used in teaching or used to log into teaching materials using MitID.
- If a teacher has given instructions that mobile phones are allowed, Nørre Gymnasium's rules of conduct apply in relation to behaviour regarding the use of IT.

2g and 3g/IB DP

• In 2g and 3g/IB DP, it is the team that decides which parts of the mobile phone policy are implemented in the individual class, as we work with a progression in digital education towards the final exam.

It appears from Nørre Gymnasium's rules of conduct that as a student you must follow the instructions from the school's staff and you are obliged to be familiar with the school's guidelines, including policies, and to follow them.

Misuse of IT during teaching gives the teacher the option of confiscating the IT equipment (computer, mobile phone, tablet) which can then be collected from the office. The individual teacher decides if computers etc. may be used in teaching and for what purpose.

Nørre Gymnasium's mobile phone policy will be evaluated before the 2024 summer holidays.
